

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, in order to facilitate the maintenance of order and the efficient conduct of the business of Chambersburg Area School District ("District") by the Board of School Directors of the District ("Board") at its regular and special meetings, the Board desires to adopt rules and regulations governing the conduct of such public meetings, and

WHEREAS, the promulgation of such rules and regulations by the Board are authorized by §710 of the Act of 1998, Oct. 15, P. L. 729, No. 93, commonly known as the "Sunshine Act", 65 Pa.C.S.A. §710.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby RESOLVED by the Board as follows:

1. At every regular or special meeting of the Board, prior to the taking of any official action by the Board, residents and/or taxpayers of the District shall be afforded the opportunity to comment on matters of concern, official action or deliberations.
2. Opportunity to comment, as above described, shall be provided for on the agenda of every regular or special meeting and shall be designated as "privilege of the floor."
3. Privilege of the floor shall be governed by the following guidelines:
 - (a) Upon recognition by the Board President, any person wishing to address the Board shall identify himself/herself by name, shall provide the Board with his/her residential address, and shall indicate whether he/she is a resident and/or taxpayer of the District.
 - (b) The period set aside by the Board for comment during privilege of the floor shall not exceed thirty (30) minutes, subject, however, to the right of the Board President to extend such period with the consent of the majority of the Board.
 - (c) Comments of any single resident and/or taxpayer shall not exceed five (5) minutes.
 - (d) Persons wishing to pose questions to Board members and/or Administration may do so during privilege of the floor; however, such questions shall be referred by the President to the Administration for timely response.
