Energy Update:

Waiting on our March bills from the Borough...so far, a 15% + savings for March and a 21% savings for 30 and $\frac{1}{2}$ months (electric/gas/oil)...soon to top \$1 million.

We've earned Energy Star Labeling/2009 status for 15 of our buildings with 2 later buildings able to qualify pending an engineer's verification. As of April 7th, there were 109 buildings in PA to earn Energy Star Labeling, 53 of those were schools...and 15 schools were in the CASD. Nationally, there were 2,734 schools labeled. A formal announcement will come on these recognitions at a future board meeting. Our District also earned the Energy Star Leader recognition for at least a 10 to 30% energy reduction for our entire portfolio and/or a rating of over 75...our rating score was 91.
