(Our first year in the program (Sept. 2007 to March 2008) compared to this year.....)



Electric..... 9/2007 to 3/2008: 12.21%.....9/2010 to 3/2011: 27.18%

Natural Gas..... 9/2007 to 3/2008: 4.88%.....9/2010 to 3/2011: 21.67%



Oil..... 9/2007 to 3/2008: 2.14%.....9/2010 to 3/2011: 16.10%

Elec/Gas/Oil..... 9/2007 to 3/2008: 8.63%.....9/2010 to 3/2011: 24.89%
